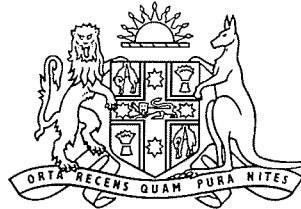

Forestry Amendment (Bungabbee State Forest Revocation) Bill 2026

Act No , 2026

An Act to amend the *Forestry Act 2012* in relation to the Bungabbee State Forest No 171; and for related purposes.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Forestry Amendment (Bungabbee State Forest Revocation) Act 2026*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

Schedule 3 Savings, transitional and other provisions

Insert at the end of the schedule, with appropriate part and clause numbering—

Part Provision consequent on enactment of Forestry Amendment (Bungabbee State Forest Revocation) Act 2026

Revocation of Bungabbee State forest and land to vest in Crown as Crown land

- (1) This clause applies to land dedicated as State forest, referred to as Bungabbee State Forest No 171, in accordance with the following notices—
 - (a) Government Gazette No 163 of 16 September 1914 at page 5569,
 - (b) Government Gazette No 164 of 20 December 1918 at page 6620,
 - (c) Government Gazette No 245 of 24 October 1919 at page 5729,
 - (d) Government Gazette No 98 of 22 July 1927 at page 3654,
 - (e) Government Gazette No 133 of 9 October 1931 at page 3468,
 - (f) Government Gazette No 172 of 2 December 1932 at page 4233,
 - (g) Government Gazette No 112 of 16 August 1940 at page 3494,
 - (h) Government Gazette No 124 of 25 September 1970 at page 3908,
 - (i) Government Gazette No 90 of 8 July 1994 at page 3515,
 - (j) Government Gazette No 25 of 26 February 1999 at page 1461.
- (2) On the commencement of this clause—
 - (a) the declaration of any part of the land as a special management zone is revoked, and
 - (b) the dedication of the land as State forest is revoked.
- (3) Immediately after the commencement of this clause, the land—
 - (a) is vested in the Crown as Crown land as an estate in fee simple, and
 - (b) is land to which the *Crown Land Management Act 2016* applies.
- (4) The vesting of land under this clause—
 - (a) does not operate to extinguish an easement in relation to the land, and
 - (b) takes effect subject to any native title rights and interests, within the meaning of the *Native Title Act 1993* of the Commonwealth, existing in relation to the land immediately before the vesting.
