No. 1 **Content of local economic structural adjustment plans**

Page 7, clause 14(4)(b), line 42. Omit all words on the line. Insert instead—

- exercising its functions in relation to the coal region, and
- (c) identify opportunities for the beneficial reuse of coal-related lands, including opportunities to—
 - (i) align economic development with biodiversity conservation and rehabilitation outcomes, and
 - (ii) support the repair or restoration of the environment, and
- (d) include a skills audit for the coal region that assesses—
 - (i) coal industry skills that may be transferred to alternative industries, and
 - (ii) obstacles to the successful transfer of those skills to alternative industries, and
 - (iii) the coal region's skill development needs and opportunities.

No. 2 **Content of local economic structural adjustment plans**

Page 8, clause 14(11). Insert after line 14—

beneficial reuse means reuse that provides social, environmental and economic benefits.
coal industry means the coal mining and coal-fired power station sectors and supply chains.
coal-related lands means land or sites held in connection with a coal mining lease or a coal-fired power station.

No. 3 **Details to be included in workforce plans for coal mines**

Page 21, clause 59(3). Insert after line 43—

- (b1) include details of the following programs or support, including the duration of the programs and support, that the holder will provide for each category of affected worker under the plan—
 - (i) retraining and skills development,
 - (ii) paid training leave,
 - (iii) career planning and financial advice,
 - (iv) access to employee organisation support,

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- (v) assistance to secure new employment,
 - (vi) time off or flexible arrangements for recruitment activities,
 - (vii) financial contributions towards training or advice costs, and
