Proposed amendments

No. 1 Commencement

Page 2, clause 2(a), line 6. Omit “Schedules 2[1]–[23], [25]–[31]”. Insert instead “Schedules 2[1]–[18], [19]–[23], [25]–[30], [31]”.

No. 2 Principles and objects

Page 4, Schedule 2. Insert after line 1—

[1A] Section 3 Principals and objects of Act

Omit “firearms.” from section 3(1)(c). Insert instead—
firearms, and

- (d) to ensure that decisions about licensing firearms users and registering firearms are made based on the following considerations—
 - (i) decisions must be evidence based and proportional to risk,
 - (ii) community safety must be achieved in the way that is the least restrictive to the rights and liberties of individuals,
 - (iii) respect must be given to private property rights.

No. 3 Seizure of firearms and ammunition if storage requirements are not met

Page 8, Schedule 2. Insert after line 4—

[18A] Section 24 Revocation of licence

Insert after section 24(2)—

- (2AA) A licence must not be revoked for a minor or technical breach of a safe keeping requirement under Part 4.

No. 4 Seizure of firearms and ammunition if storage requirements are not met

Page 8, Schedule 2. Insert after line 41—

[23A] Section 42 Seizure of firearms and ammunition if storage requirements not met

Omit “without delay” from section 42(2). Insert instead “within 28 days”.

No. 5 **Fees not to increase by more than CPI**

Page 11, Schedule 2. Insert after line 8—

[30A] Section 88 Regulations

Insert after section 88(2)—

- (2A) A fee prescribed by the regulations must not increase by more than the Sydney All Groups Consumer Price Index Number for the previous financial year published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

No. 6 **Offences created by regulations**

Page 11, Schedule 2. Insert before line 9—

[30B] Section 88(3)

Omit the subsection.
