No. 1 **Application of provision**

Page 3, Schedule 1[1], proposed section 7(1), lines 6–8. Omit all words on the lines. Insert instead—

- (1) This section applies to a person if—
 - (a) the person is summoned to attend and give evidence before the Council or Assembly or a Committee by a notice or order as referred to in section 4, and
 - (b) at the time the summons was issued, the person is or had been—
 - (i) a holder of a public office under the Government of New South Wales, or
 - (ii) employed in the Public Service of New South Wales under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*, or
 - (iii) employed by the Government of New South Wales in the service of the Crown in another service of the Crown established by an Act of Parliament, or
 - (iv) employed by a statutory body that is a NSW Government agency or by a person holding a public office under the Government of New South Wales, or
 - (v) appointed or employed as an officer or employee of either House of Parliament or as an officer under the separate control of the President or Speaker or under the President's and Speaker's joint control, or
 - (vi) engaged under a contract or other arrangement to provide services to the Crown, a statutory body that is a NSW Government agency, a person holding a public office under the Government of New South Wales or the Parliament, either House of Parliament, the President or the Speaker.
