Proposed amendments

No. 1 **Certain digitally generated electoral material prohibited**

Page 18, Schedule 1[81], proposed section 189A, line 29. Omit all words on the line. Insert instead—

- (b) does not include—
 - (i) a cartoon or animated drawing, or
 - (ii) electoral material that is of a kind, or generated in a way, prescribed by the regulations.

No. 2 **Certain digitally generated electoral material prohibited**

Page 18, Schedule 1[81], proposed section 189A. Insert after line 35—

- (5) The Minister must not recommend the making of a regulation under subsection (4), definition of *digitally generated electoral material*, paragraph (b)(ii) during the following periods—
 - (a) the period—
 - (i) commencing on 1 October in the year before a general election, and
 - (ii) ending on the election day for the general election,
 - (b) the period—
 - (i) commencing on the date of the issue of the writ for a by-election, and
 - (ii) ending on the day of the by-election.

No. 3 **Certain digitally generated electoral material prohibited**

Page 18, Schedule 1[81], proposed section 189B, lines 37–39. Omit all words on the lines. Insert instead—

- (1) A person must not, during the regulated period, print, publish, distribute or publicly display digitally generated electoral material that depicts a digitally created person, event or place that a reasonable person would think is an actual person, event or place unless the material contains—
