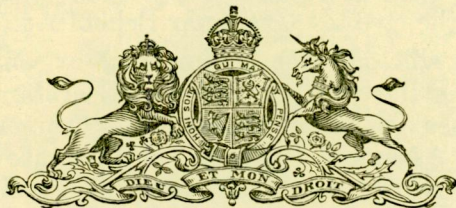

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

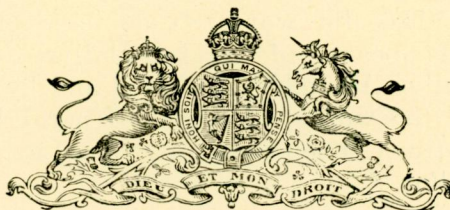

## Sydney Grammar School (Amendment) Bill.

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### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THIS measure provides for the amendment of the Sydney Grammar School Act in one respect only, i.e., the constitution of the Board of Trustees. The Act of 1854 provided for a Board of Trustees comprising six ex-officio members and six laymen. Included among the ex-officio members are the Speaker of the Legislative Council and the Provost of the University of Sydney, neither of which offices exists.

It is therefore proposed to alter the composition of the Board by substituting—

- (1) the President of the Legislative Council,
- (2) the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, and
- (3) the Chancellor of the University of Sydney

for—

- (a) the "Colonial Secretary,"
- (b) the "Speaker of the Legislative Council," and
- (c) the "Provost of the University."
