I lived in the Mittagong area from 1942 until 1989. I worked as a timber cutter all of my life while living there.

I cut timber in many forests around Mittagong including Joadja and Bullio Tops, both of which are on the Wombeyan Caves Rd.

I went to the Joadja one day in 1983 and I visited a flat rock that was above a rock shelter, I found thousands of bullet shells as well as a dozen cans of beer, in the shelter I found a piece of timber with "Milat" routered onto it and I also found another piece of timber with "Camden" routered onto it on the ground.

I have tried to talk with the Goulburn police about this cave/ rock shelter, they were interested but have not been able to take me to look at this cave since.

I have spoken with local police and they said this shelter may be a "Milat killing field"

I believe that this may be true.

I would like to share some maps that are attached, I have marked on the maps the car park where you stop on the Wombeyan Caves Road.

I have marked where the rock shelter is, it is 1.6 km approx from the Wombeyan Caves Rd.
