

**INQUIRY INTO UNSOLVED MURDERS AND LONG-TERM

Driving home from a job (employed with NSW Rail) from a location called Summit Tank one evening around 1990 about 17:00. On the way home via Mt Kembla along fire road 15 I came around a bend in the road to a clearing on my right hand side. On passing this clearing I noticed two people who were at something behind a log. On seeing me one man ran appearing to try and hide whilst the other just stood there and stared at me as I drove past. I looked but did not notice any car. This was just before the power lines and not far from the rail crossing. Not long after this was when Ivan Milat was caught and after seeing his picture, this was the individual that stood and stared at me driving past.

I did contact the Police Ivan hot line and left a message, and since I have left a message on the Police Crimestoppers line and mentioned/talked to a few other police about this. The police that I did talk to 2 of whom were involved in the case did mention with what I have told them that it was Ivan that I saw.

To this date I have not had any official response from the police on this issue.
