Dear Inquiry Members:

This is my submission to the inquiry into dingoes in national parks in New South Wales.

In NSW, dingoes are the only native animal in Australia however they are not protected under the Biodiversity Conservation Act. This is APPALLING!! This inquiry is an opportunity to correct this and protect our native species. Every person in this country except for our Aboriginal people are INVASIVE species - and while we all now call this land our home, our behaviours towards animals, and NATIVE species who have been here before us is unconscionable.

The use of 1080 poison, baiting, trapping, and shooting to "manage" dingoes in national parks is horrific and unbelievable and a risk to all other species. Who on earth thought that this is the way we manage a native species? That person or committee will have such cruelty on their conscience!! These cruel practices being applied to sentient animals, have no place in a modern approach to our wildlife preservation.

You really need to have people from the Animal Justice Party and our Aboriginal Community sitting on any such committees to input into such decision making. If you do not - then it seems to me completely absurd and immoral to have an invasive group of people deciding the fate of native species!!!

Killing in ANY FORM of ANY LIVING BEING MUST be carefully considered so you are not impacting the collective soul of the human race.

Why dont you take some learnings from what is happening in Europe where after so much destruction they are having to back track and start protect so many species being driven to extinction. Let us not go so far down this route of killing that we cannot return.

I urge the committee recommend AS A MATTER OF URGENCY that dingoes be given FULL LEGISLATIVE PROTECTION in NSW. That lethal control methods are to be considered only in absolutely dire situations and that they are replaced with humane, non-lethal alternatives if required at all.
