

43 ORDER FOR PAPERS—LOCAL SMALL COMMITMENTS ALLOCATION

Mr Rath, by leave, amended private members' business item no. 1595 by:

- (1) Omitting "21 days" and inserting instead "72 days".
- (2) Inserting "documents tabled on Wednesday 20 November 2024 and" after "excluding".

Mr Rath moved, according to notice, as by leave amended: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 72 days of the date of passing of this resolution all documents, excluding documents tabled on Wednesday 20 November 2024 and any documents previously returned under an order of the House, created since 28 March 2023, in the possession, custody or control of the Premier, the Deputy Premier, Minister for Education and Early Learning and Minister for Western Sydney, the Special Minister of State, Minister for Roads, Minister for the Arts, Minister for Music and the Night-time Economy and Minister for Jobs and Tourism, the Treasurer, the Minister for Local Government, the Minister for Finance, Minister for Domestic Manufacturing and Government Procurement and Minister for Natural Resources, the Premier's Department, The Cabinet Office, the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (Office of Local Government) or the Treasury relating to the Local Small Commitments Allocation, and any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
