

30 ORDER FOR PAPERS—BAYSIDE COUNCIL AND CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Mr Rath, by leave, amended private members' business item no. 1892 by:

- (1) In paragraph (a)(ii) omitting "preparations for" and inserting instead "preparations, reports or referrals for now-concluded"
- (2) Omitting paragraphs (a)(iv) to (vi).
- (3) Omitting paragraph (b).
- (4) Omitting paragraph (d).
- (5) In paragraph (f) inserting "now-concluded proceedings, including" after "relating to".

Mr Rath moved, according to notice, as by leave amended: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 21 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents in the possession, custody or control of the Premier, the Minister for Local Government, Minister for Lands and Property, Minister for Multiculturalism, Minister for Sport and Minister for Jobs and Tourism, the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (including the Office of Local Government) or the Premier's Department relating to Bayside Council and conflicts of interest:

- (a) all documents, including ministerial correspondence, relating to:
 - (i) the former Mayor of Bayside, Mr Bill Saravinovski and The Boulevarde carpark in Brighton-Le-Sands,
 - (ii) the former Mayor of Bayside, Mr Bill Saravinovski and preparations, reports or referrals for now-concluded proceedings by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal or the Independent Commission Against Corruption,
 - (iii) potential and actual conflicts of interest relating to The Boulevarde carpark in Brighton-Le-Sands involving the current General Manager of Bayside Council,
- (b) all communication, including emails and text messages, between the Minister for Local Government and the former Mayor of Bayside, Mr Bill Saravinovski,
- (c) all documents in the possession, custody or control of the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure relating to property interests in the Bayside Council local government area of:
 - (i) Mr Bill Saravinovski,
 - (ii) Mr Shaoquett Moselmane,
 - (iii) the Member for Rockdale, Steve Kamper,
 - (iv) Mr Bill Kamper,
 - (v) Cr Edward McDougall,
 - (vi) Cr Chris Saravinovski,
 - (vii) Cr Joe Awada,
- (d) all documents in the possession, custody or control of the Office of Local Government relating to now-concluded proceedings, including:
 - (i) the commissioning by the Office of Local Government of barrister Matthew Cobb-Clark,
 - (ii) communication with barrister Matthew Cobb-Clark,
 - (iii) briefing notes to the Minister for Local Government,
 - (iv) records of meetings with the Minister for Local Government, and
- (e) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
